Our Bachelor of IT has a strong industry focus and offers a choice of two majors, Digital Enterprise or Business Information Systems. You can also take both majors. This is designed to set you up effectively for your future career as an IT professional. Your studies are also supported by a work placement in your final year, where you have the opportunity to apply your learning in a real work setting.

Topics include in-depth exploration of IT infrastructure technologies; the technical and business elements required to analyse, design, implement, manage, and support complex IT resources, transformative business solutions, enterprise architecture, networks, virtual and cloud-based deployment.

On campus resources include IT Labs, workshop areas, learning materials, and a Library & Student Success Hub. Our courses are also very flexible – you can undertake them at a pace that suits you (subject to VISA requirements).

Sydney International offers innovative courses approved as meeting the Australian Qualifications Framework, and are designed to meet the requirements of the Australian Computer Society (ACS).

Entry requirements

General requirement

- A minimum of 18 years of age on commencement of studies
- A satisfactory Australian student visa
- Health insurance cover for your time in Australia

Academic requirement

- Australian secondary qualification at/above New South Wales ATAR 60 (or equivalent)
- Overseas qualification at/above New South Wales ATAR 60 (or equivalent) listed at <https://www.uac.edu.au/future-applicants/admission-criteria/overseas-qualifications>, OR
- VET Certificate III or above in a relevant discipline, OR
- Satisfactory completion of at least one year of accredited full-time study at AQF level 4 or above in Australia, OR
- Completion of an Australian University Enabling Program, OR
- Recognition of other appropriate prior learning

English proficiency

- IELTS of 6 with no band lower than 5.5 (or equivalent TOEFL or Pearson Test) for BIT Program
- IELTS of 5.5 (or equivalent) for Diploma Programs
